ESA applications are accepted year round and complete applications will be processed within 30 days of submission.

ESA funds are distributed quarterly and funding *begins* the quarter that the ESA contract is signed. For example, an ESA contract that is signed at any point in Q1, will receive Q1 funding, a contract signed in Q2, will receive Q2 funding, etc.

IMPORTANT NOTE: It does take approximately 3 weeks to set up and fund a **new ESA account**. See the **ESA Parent Guide** for more information.

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Q: What if my vendor is not on the merchant list?

A: Vendor must complete a registration form and they must follow up with ADE & Class Wallet for approval.

In-Person Private Schools

In-Person / Online Learning Program: Programs that deliver learning entirely through the internet/online. Examples of individual learning programs include but are not limited to: reading, math, coding, foreign languages, spelling, science, art, social studies.

Online Private Schools: Private schools that deliver K-12 instruction (education) entirely online.

Paraprofessionals: This category is for providers who assist a parent or tutor with the educational needs of a child with a disability only and who have one of the following credentials: Praxis ParaPro, ACT Workeys, or ParaEducator. A copy of the official passing scores must be submitted.

Physical Education (organization or facility only)

Post-Secondary Institution

Therapists: This category is for providers who have a therapy license that is not expired. Examples of therapy services include, but are not limited to: speech therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, equine/horse therapy, music therapy, hand therapy, vision therapy, art therapy, aquatic therapy, ABA, recreational therapy, RDI, social group.

Tutor - Core Subject: This category if for providers who have a valid state, national, or regional credential such as state teaching certificate, bachelor's degree or higher. Examples of Core Subject Tutoring include but are not limited to: math, science, reading, language arts, social studies or similar subjects (such as state teaching certificate, bachelor's degree or higher.

Tutor - Specific Subject: This category if for providers who have specific national, or regional credentials in their specific area. Examples of Specific Subject Tutoring include but are not limited to: physical education, swimming, driver's education, dance, music, art, drama, foreign language, martial arts, gymnastics, yoga.

Uniform Vendors: Vendors that supply school uniforms. These vendors must be approved by a qualified private school.

Arizona Department of Education is using ClassWallet for parents to manage and make payments using their Empowerment Scholarship Accounts (ESA).

In order to receive payment from ESA, you will need to complete the following steps:

- The pre-registration form found on this page. *If you are a
 paraprofessional, therapist, or tutor you must provide proof of certification
 and the expiration date of the certification.
- Upon approval, you will receive an email with a link to the ClassWallet website and the required next steps.

Please note, we are unable to provide business or tax advice, nor offer any guidance related to vendor category selection including the types of services to provide to ESA families. For these types of questions please consult with a private business advisor. Additionally, if you have questions regarding credentials, please review the credential requirements in the ESA Parent Handbook. Finally, if you do not receive a response to your submission in 3-5 business days, please resubmit a new registration form. ClassWallet and/or the Department reserves the right to deny a registration or remove a vendor at any time.
